### INTERMEDIATE INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM FOR EXPANDING INCIDENTS

#### Course Description:

This three-day course provides training for all individuals who may assume a supervisory role in expanding incidents. The course outlines how the NIMS Command & Coordination component supports the management of expanding incidents, as well as describing the incident management processes as prescribed by the Incident Command System. Through activities, students will have an opportunity to practice implementing the incident management process and create an Incident Action Plan for a simulated expanding incident.
